IAG COMMUNIQUE

In accordance with its Work Plan for 2002, the International Advisory Group (IAG) will undertake its next working visit from April 7 to 18.

Taking into account the electoral context in Chad and its desire to see more closely the situation in Cameroon, the first part of this working visit will be entirely devoted to Cameroon. The IAG thus hopes to continue the dialogue with its interlocutors, political and administrative, business, trade unions and civil society. These plans include a visit of Campo Mann National Park and to follow part of the pipeline route between Yaoundé and Dompta.

Contacts are presently being established to finalize arrangements for this programme.

The IAG plans to undertake the second part of this visit, in Chad, from 3 to 13 June. Communications with our interlocutors will be undertaken in the later part of April to prepare for that visit.
